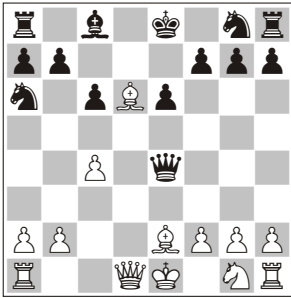


## Greed is Not a Vice?!

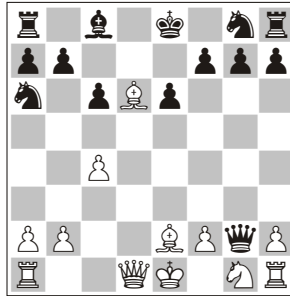

### The New Main Line

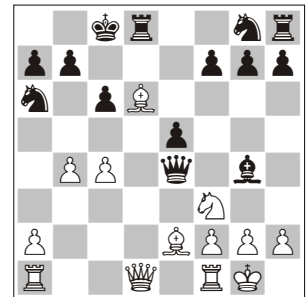
In my earlier article I lamented that, for reasons not altogether clear to me, the capture of the second pawn  $9...♚g2$  had hardly ever occurred in grandmaster play.

### Mamedyarov's Idea

In the variation  $9...e5$   $10.♞f3$   $♙g4$   $11.0-0$   $0-0-0$ , as I expected, the main attention has been focused on Mamedyarov's idea –  $12.b4$ .



After  $12...♞f6$  Riazantsev against Galkin successfully employed Mamedyarov's  $13.♞e1$ , but  $13.c5!?$ , recommended in the previous article, has occurred

Just a year (or four issues of the Yearbook) ago I wrote an article about the Slav Gambit of Frank Marshall, or more precisely about its most topical line –  $9.♙d6$  – and already sufficient material has accumulated for a worthwhile update. Even so, it is unlikely that I would have returned so quickly to this topic, had it not been for some impressive wins by Dusko Pavasovic. At the last European Championship in Dresden (April 2007) in two successive 'Black' games he defeated Van Wely and Moiseenko, both games developing in identical fashion until move 27, and this by no means as a result of a previous study of the given variation!

Apparently these reasons were 'not altogether clear' not only to me. During the last year it is this line that has become the main topic of discussion in the Slav Marshall Gambit. For the moment, thanks to the victories of the Slovenian grandmaster, success has been on Black's side. Perhaps after  $10.♚d2$   $♞f6$   $11.♙f3$   $♚g6$   $12.0-0-0$  (or  $12.♞e2$   $e5$ )  $12...e5$  White has been wrong to continue playing for the rapid development of his initiative. I think that he should partly restore the material balance by  $13.♙e5$   $0-0$   $14.♞e2$ , and in the event of  $14...♚f5$  continued  $15.♚e3$   $♞b4$   $16.♞d4!$  with favourable complications. However, it must be mentioned that  $14...♚f5$  is not the only move...

more often. Here too the opening battles have developed to White's advantage, but as yet there has been no practical testing of **13...♖b4!?**, the most critical move, in my view.

### New Attempts by White

The variation **9...b6 10.♖f3 ♖b7 11.0-0** has also occurred many times. After **11...♗d8** I thought

that White could successfully develop his initiative with **12.♗d2 c5 13.♗ad1**, but **12.♖g5!?**, as employed by Dobrov, looks more concrete. – **11...0-0-0** is stronger for Black. Halkias against Tzermiadianos replied to this with the gambit **12.♗d3 ♗g4 14.c5!** and gained compensation. But whether it is sufficient to evaluate the position

in favour of White is not something I would assert...

### Conclusion

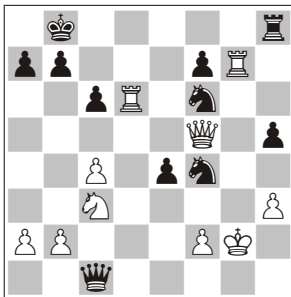
Summing up, it can be said that during the past year after **9...e5** and **9...b6** it is more often White who has been successful in practice, while after **9...♗g2** it is Black. But undoubtedly this is merely an interim result...
